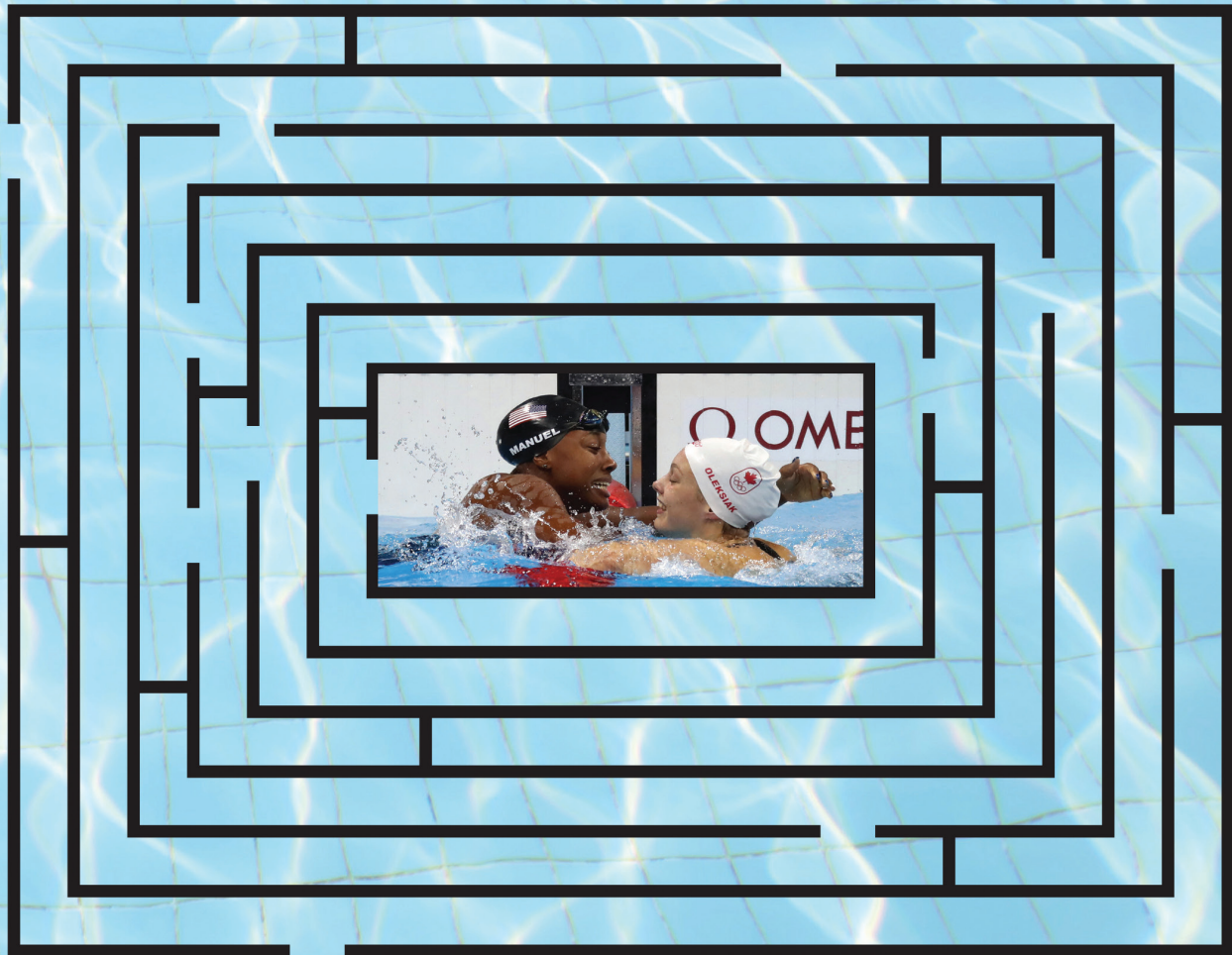
DOTS ON THE BALL

They help air flow more smoothly over the ball and help it go straight. This ball has a special pattern of dots. All-Star Facts

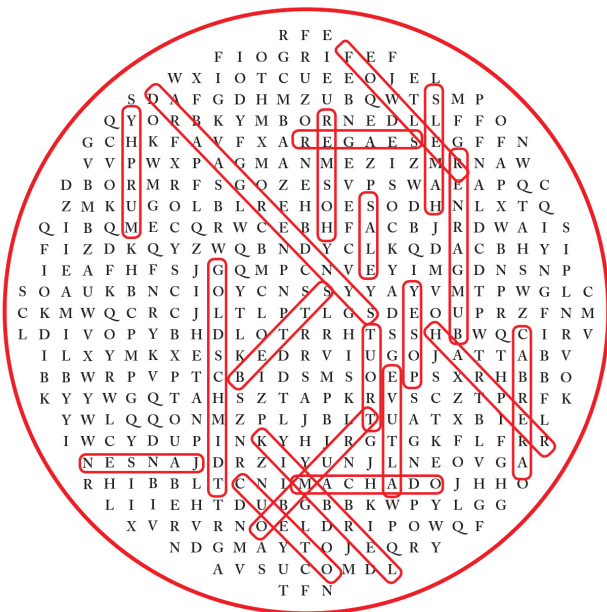
Each swimmer touches a special electronic pad at the end of a race. It stops the clock for that swimmer, so race officials know who had the fastest times.

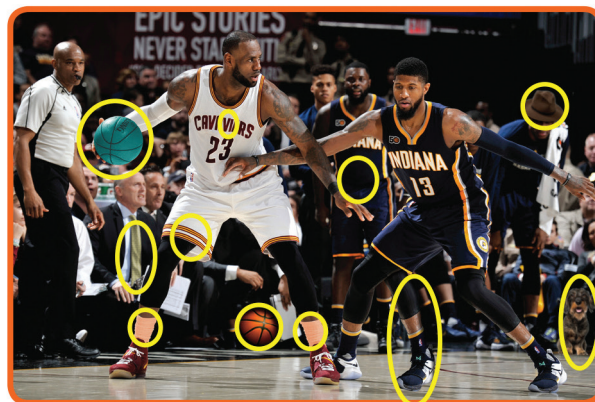
